Virginia Bar Association installs Stephen D. Busch as president and Pia Trigiani as president-elect at 2010 annual meeting

The Virginia Bar Association (VBA) installed Stephen D. Busch of Richmond as its president and elected Lucia Anna "Pia" Trigiani of Alexandria as president-elect at the Association's 120th annual meeting on January 23 in Williamsburg. The VBA is the largest voluntary bar association in Virginia.

Busch is a partner in the toxic tort and environmental litigation department at McGuireWoods in Richmond. He is a member of the law firm's executive committee and board of partners. His past VBA service has included chairing of the VBA's Young Lawyers Division, its Civil Litigation Section and its board of governors. He was the Association's president-elect in 2009. He is a graduate of the University of Virginia and received his law degree from the University of Richmond.

Trigiani is a founding partner of MercerTrigiani in Alexandria. She has chaired the Real Estate Section of the VBA, has been a member of the VBA Administrative Law Section Council and has served as chair of the VBA board of governors. She is a past president of the Washington Metropolitan Chapter of Community Associations Institute ("CAI") and has chaired CAI's Government and Public Affairs Committee. She is a graduate of Saint Mary's College, Notre Dame, and received her law degree from the University of Richmond.

The Association also elected new board of governors members, including James M. Hingeley of the Office of the Public Defender in Charlottesville, Leighton S. In other action of the Association at its annual meeting, the VBA's Young Lawyers Division installed Henry I. Willett of Christian & Barton in Richmond as its 2010 chair

and elected B. Webb King of Woods Rogers in Roanoke as chair-elect. Both will also serve on the VBA board of governors.
